#### Introduction


# After just 8 months with us and 14 paid campaigns currently running across multiple platforms, these are the results

- Decreased their average CPC by 50 as a result of keyword research and optimal use of their marketing budget.
- Engaging content that gains user retention of 30 in Youtube videos as retargeting ads.
- Drive traffic into the website through optimized digital campaigns and landing pages to increase visits by 200 .
- More than 70 of the websites traffic is coming from paid campaigns in Google search and display thanks to FreeAgent s increased activity in digital platforms.


